

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Guelph/Eramosa passed By-law No. 18/2014, on the 18th day of February, 2014, under Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. Chapter P. 13, as amended.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the last date for filing a notice of appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law is the **13th day of March, 2014**. A Notice of Appeal setting out the reasons for the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the Township of Guelph/Eramosa and accompanied by the appropriate fee as required by the Ontario Municipal Board.

NOTE: Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a zoning by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

AN EXPLANATION of the purpose and effect of the by-law and a key map showing the lands 7305-7309 Side Road 14 (Part of Lot 14, Concession 2, East of Grand River, being Part 1 on 61R3699, former Township of Pilkington, now the Township of Guelph/Eramosa) to which the by-law applies, is shown below. The complete by-law passed as By-law No. 18/2014 is available for inspection in the Clerk's Office located at 8348 Wellington Road 124 (at Brucedale), during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.).

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

By-law 18/2014 amends By-law 57/1999, being a Zoning By-law controlling land use development within the Township of Guelph/Eramosa. The purpose of the by-law is to apply a special provision to the property (7305-7309 Side Road 14) to permit the continuation of a previously established garden suite for a period of time not exceeding three (3) years from the day of passing of By-law No. 18/2014.
