**Re: James Dick Construction Limited, Proposed Hidden Quarry
Site Plan Revisions
Project No.: 300032475.0000**

It has been noted that Site Plan Drawings as prepared for the Hidden Quarry under the Aggregate Resources Act have been plotted on various dates. This has resulted from iterative revisions to the Site Drawings to address specific issues raised by various agencies. We note that the current drawings posted on the Township's Website are dated June 6, 2014 and represent drawings which were forwarded to the GRCA on that date.

Later revision dates for the Site Plan Drawings include July 14, 2014, August 1, 2014 and December 2014 with the latest revisions to the drawings plotted on March 19th, 2015.

We provide the following chronology of the revisions made to the Site Plan Drawings between June 2014 and March 2015 as follows:

June to July

- Fifth bullet under Level II Natural Environment Technical notes on page 2 of 5 changed to reflect GRCA comment regarding timing of culvert construction.
- A table entitled Trigger Levels and Contingency Measures was added on Page 4 of 5. This table is also referred to on Page 2 of 5 (Operations Plan). The table summarizes Trigger Levels as requested by the GRCA and provides Contingency Measures that shall be implemented.
- References to Ash were removed from the tree species list. It was included on the species list in reference to the ELC Community list for Carbonate Treed Cliff Ecosite.
- A note to eliminate vegetation clearing during the bird breeding season was added. See note 26 on page 2 of 5.
- A note was added concerning Tree Protection Silt Fencing on Page 4 of 5 under the heading Sediment and Erosion Control, as well as adding the fence on page 2 of 5 (Operations Plan).

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July to August

- Updated table on page 2 for the monitoring plan in the hydrogeology recommendations.

August to December

- Drawing 1 – added M18 and M19 (proposed additional monitoring wells as requested by Halton Region) onto the map of wells.
- Drawing 2 – updated table for monitoring in the hydrogeological recommendations.
- Drawing 4 – updated table for trigger levels and contingency measures.

December to March 2015

- Drawing 2 - 5th bullet under Level II Environmental Technical Report read April 1- June 31. This was corrected to June 30.
- There were a number of instances on the plans that read "should". These were changed to "will".
- Reference to MNR changed to MNRF and similarly MOE changed to MOECC.

We enclose a copy of the Site Plans dated March 19th, 2015 and recommend that these latest Site Plans be placed on the Township's Website. If you have any questions in regard to the above, please do not hesitate to contact our office.
