 1902 - Joseph House built this frame building as a home with a general store in one room.
 1908 - Post Office established with the arrival of the railroad.
 1918 - Hand gas pumps added.
 1958 - Pumps became electric. The store joined the "Lucky Dollar" grocery chain.
 1960 - Building expanded to its present size.
 2008 - Ariss Post Office honoured for 100 years of service.
