

MAXIMUM CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURES 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

According to the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, the Clerk is to provide an estimate of the candidate's spending limit upon filing of the nomination paper. The estimate is to be based on the voters' list from the previous election. A **FINAL** spending limit is to be provided no later than 10 days after nomination day (September 12, 2014), based on the voters' list from the current election. The higher amount prevails.

The candidate spending limit for offices is below:

Spending limit for the Office of the Mayor is calculated by adding together \$7,500 plus 85 cents for each elector entitled to vote for the office. Spending limit for another Office is calculated by adding together \$5,000 plus 85 cents for each elector entitled to vote for the office. (NOTE: O. Reg. 499/09, made on December 17, 2009, amended the spending limit calculation by increasing 70 cents to 85 cents)
