Student Urban Forest Technician/Arborist - 1 Position

Primary Duties

The Arborist Student is responsible for creating, maintaining and updating a tree inventory within the Township of Guelph/Eramosa through field inspection and assessment of species, location, size and condition of trees located on Township property.

Qualifications

The successful candidate must be currently enrolled in full-time studies in an Arboriculture, Urban Forestry or related education program at community college or university; and returning to full-time studies in the following school term. Ability to correctly identify various types of trees is required. The successful candidate will also have strong research and organizational skills, as well as proficiency with data management. A valid, unrestricted Ontario Class G Drivers License and access to a vehicle is required.

Successful applicants must be available to start Monday May 1st, 2017 and work through to Friday August 25th, 2017.
