

Addendum Number 1, April 18, 2016

The following paragraph replaces the first paragraph of Section 5.0, Study Area Review:

5.2 Proposed Licensed Area

The licensed area borders Sixth Line on its western boundary. The Sixth Line rural roadscape is a cultural heritage landscape based on its tree lined rural profile and remaining three nineteenth century farmsteads to the north of the property. These three farmsteads are well separated from the site, the closest being approximately 250 metres north west. The applicant intends to maintain/supplement the treed verge of the roadway and design landscaped berms inside the existing tree line (see separate Visual Information Package prepared by James Dick Construction Limited and peer reviewed by Brook McIlroy Inc.). Although the southerly section of the Sixth Line will be re-graded and paved to a point just north of the new quarry entrance, there will be no visual impact on the rural roadscape north of that point.
