The Township of Guelph/Eramosa is a vibrant rural and small urban municipality located at the south end of Wellington County which includes the settlement areas of Rockwood, Eden Mills, Everton, Ariss and Cross Creek.

The Township is currently seeking applications for a Parks and Recreation Maintenance Technician beginning April 1st, 2019 and working through to and including November 8th, 2019. Reporting to the Parks and Recreation Foreman, the primary duties of this position include assisting with the operation of the seasonal Parks Maintenance program as well as: general maintenance, assisting with construction projects, maintaining parks and buildings, operating commercial mowers and landscape equipment and assisting with special functions as required.

The successful candidate will have a valid Ontario unrestricted G Drivers License, possess previous experience in parks and/or landscaping setting and have previous experience in building/parks maintenance. Good communication skills and the ability to deal with the public in a courteous and effective manner; ability to work independently and in a team environment; and the capability to perform physical tasks in varying environmental conditions is a requirement for this position. Previous experience in operating commercial landscape equipment is a must. First Aid and/or CPR training and a DZ licence would be considered an asset. The work location for this position is a rural property without bus service.

Successful applicants may be required to work weekends on a rotating schedule and will be placed on an afterhours "on-call" schedule.
