In order to participate:

- 1. You must provide a brief typed bio (one paragraph) with a description of your art piece. This can be submitted with your application and payment at the Brucedale Township office or emailed to kcoultis@get.on.ca by Monday, May 29.
- 2. A \$20 entrance fee is required to offset the cost of set-up and the opening night reception.
- 3. Artwork must be submitted by Monday, May 29.

All submissions must be suitably framed, wired and ready to install, if not, you risk the chance of your piece not being displayed.

- 5. Artwork may be picked up after the Homegrown exhibit from the Rockwood Library any time after Wednesday, June 28, between 10am 8pm. Submissions must be picked up no later than Tuesday, July 4. The Rockwood Branch of the Wellington County Library will not be responsible for artwork left after Tuesday, July 4, 2017.
- 6. Artists should plan to attend the Homegrown Opening Reception at the Rockwood Library and the Older Adult Centre on Thursday, June 1 from 5:30 7:30 p.m.
- 7. If you are selling your artwork, you will be responsible for all aspects of the transaction, including contacting purchaser, financial agreements and the transfer of art **AFTER** completion of the Homegrown show. There will be no exceptions.
- 8. Your artwork should be insured, as the Rockwood Branch of the Wellington County Library or Guelph/Eramosa Township will not be held liable for any damage. (See below)
- 9. Please pick up invitations to the Opening Reception from the library or the Older Adult Centre during the month of May to hand out to friends, relatives and acquaintances.

Waiver of Liability Information

This waiver of Liability between Guelph/Eramosa Township, and the artist waives any liability on the part of the Township or its employees with regard to a public exhibition by the Artist of his /her works of art ("Works") to be held at The Rockwood Branch of the Wellington County Library.

The Artist hereby agrees to hold harmless Guelph/Eramosa Township and/or its employees and volunteers from any liability for the Artist of the Works including but not restricted to damage to or theft of the Works.

This waiver stipulates that ownership of Works sold during the exhibition shall not be transferred from the Artist to a purchaser until after the Closing Date. Receipts made out to purchasers shall be marked "Deposit on artwork".

It is hereby understood by and between Guelph/Eramosa Township and the Artist that the only intention of Guelph/Eramosa Township is to provide a venue for the exhibition of the Works during the above period and that Guelph/Eramosa Township can accept no responsibility or liability for the Artists or the Works.

Signatures on the application portion indicate agreement with all of the above.

The committee reserves the right to refuse any art. Your work will be placed where the Homegrown committee deems possible.
