

NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE Seventh Line Railway Crossing

Please be advised that the railway crossing on Seventh Line will be closed by Metrolinx beginning on Friday, May 15th at 10:00 a.m. and continue through to the morning of Monday, May 18th to rehabilitate the crossing by repairing the rail and leveling the grade.

Please note that Seventh Line will be closed to both vehicles and pedestrians at the tracks. On Seventh Line North of the tracks, EMS will be accessible through Harris St from Rockwood.

Wellington County Track Improvements

Metrolinx is continuing essential maintenance work along the rail corridor passing through Georgetown to Kitchener on GO Transit's Kitchener line. Starting on **May 15** we will begin work in your community to upgrade the Metrolinx rail crossing at 7th Line in Wellington County.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

Weather permitting, work to rehabilitate the crossing by repairing the rail and leveling the grade crossing will begin **Friday**, **May 15 at 10:00 p.m.** and continue through to the morning of **Monday**, **May 18**, **2020**.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

While this work is underway, 7th Line will be closed to both vehicles and pedestrians at the tracks.

We will do our best to complete track maintenance during the day, but some work will need to proceed overnight while rail traffic is lighter. Residents may notice noise from the machinery and some ambient light from the site. The use of back-up beepers, a vital safety measure, will be limited to essential work only. Lights will be pointed away from residential areas.
