1 Relief School Crossing Guard

The Township of Guelph/Eramosa employs three part-time School Crossing Guards at crossing locations within the Village of Rockwood. We are currently looking for one (1) Relief School Crossing Guard to provide coverage for any of the three crossing locations as required.

The Relief School Crossing Guard is an on-call part-time position that highly contributes to our Township by escorting children across Highway 7 in Rockwood at designated school crossing locations from 7:45 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. as required from September to June. The Relief School Crossing Guard position will not be required to direct traffic, however the School Crossing Guards must be alert and observant to changing traffic conditions and direct children waiting to cross in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act, Occupational Health and Safety Act and the Township of Guelph/Eramosa guidelines.

Successful candidates must be 16 years of age or older, possess the ability to work outside in diverse weather conditions and carry a stop sign paddle intermittently. The Relief School Crossing Guard will be committed, possess strong public service skills, a safety conscious attitude and obey all established traffic/health and safety regulations.

Successful candidates must submit a Vulnerable Sector Check to the Township of Guelph/Eramosa as a condition of employment and will be required to perform the physical aspects of the position including: standing, walking for prolonged periods of time and required visual and hearing motor skills. First Aid and CPR training for this position are a definite asset.

The rate of pay is **\$ 17.31** per hour.
