I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to address some important points regarding Bell's proposed replacement tower site proposed to be constructed at the Township's recreation centre in Marden.

First and foremost, I want to assure you that Bell's tower site will fully complies with Health Canada's Safety Code 6, which sets out stringent safety guidelines for radiofrequency exposure. Bell takes its commitment to public safety very seriously and adheres to all applicable regulations and standards.

Furthermore, Bell only operates its wireless network on licensed frequencies allocated by the Canadian government. This means that Bell is not permitted to interfere in other parts of the radio spectrum, including services run by the municipality. In the unlikely event of an interference issue, Bell would be legally required to investigate and address the matter immediately, including addressing any applicable EMCAB bulletins.
